## ABOUT THE COURSE

The Southern States Rhinology Foundation course features a comprehensive update on the medical and surgical practice of rhinology. This course is for otolaryngologists and features presentations on topics from a distinguished faculty of academic otolaryngologists throughout the Southeast.

## LAB

A hands-on laboratory dissection is also available with this course. Participants will have the opportunity to dissect cadaver specimens featuring state-of-the-art endoscopic instrumentation, video, and image guidance system (IGS).

## OBJECTIVES

- Understand the definition and etiologies of chronic rhinosinusitis and concepts in medical treatment.
- List the indications for and techniques of basic and advanced endoscopic surgical procedures.
- Describe the utility of image-guided surgery.
- Demonstrate basic and advanced endoscopic surgical techniques including approaches to the sphenoid sinus, frontal sinus, orbit, and the skull base.
- Recognize and manage complications of endoscopic sinus surgery.
